


## LUIZA MILEWICZ: SUBLIME LIGHT AN EXHIBITION FOR THE SPIRITUALLY INCLINED

**Sydney, NSW – March 2024; Sublime Light** is a solo exhibition of new works by **Luiza Milewicz** at Disorder Gallery. The exhibition dates are March 28 thru April 13, 2024. A reception for the artist will be held on Thursday, March 28, from 5 to 7 pm.

**Sublime Light** is an exhibition for the spiritually minded, in which light is presented as sublime through its counter opposite- darkness, to bestow a feeling of wonder using modern LED technology, highlighting the experience of viewing and being immersed.

In conjunction with the sublime, the show explores sacred geometry as the divine building blocks of life, where light symbolises the divine presence from which all things are created, from the structure of atoms, to the motions of celestial bodies, to the spectrum of energy waves. With a focus on these concepts and using a range of media, Luiza Milewicz's work attempts to visualise the exquisite ways that nature puts itself together to symmetrically organise shape, line, colour, and dimension in a diversity of puzzles and patterns.

In today's world of illuminating technological noise where televisions, computers, and iPhones are imminent distractors, *Sublime Light* seeks to compensate for the spiritual loss of modern society by introducing a sense of harmony and balance. It is a step into Luiza's introspective and meditative space where she investigates and contemplates the essence of these shapes, patterns and relationships, in an effort to reflect not only on the mysteries and laws of our universe, but also on our own existence and spirituality.

**Luiza Milewicz** carries a Masters degree from UNSW Art and Design, and has exhibited her works at numerous exhibitions, galleries, and retail venues in Australia and overseas. Currently working from her home studio, she continues to develop cutting-edge sculpture using light technology and sacred geometry to attract balance and harmony. Luiza combines skills in art and design to produce artwork that is simultaneously decorative and functional.
